WOODYISMS

November is in the rearview mirror, and we are looking at December through the windshield. December ushers in the winter holidays Christmas, Kwanza, Chanukah and New Years Eve. It is also a time when families gather in the warmth of their homes. Throughout the month, our thoughts and actions turn toward charity and peace. During this twelfth and final month of the year, we experience a flurry of activity both in the business world and our personal lives. Sales, shopping, family gatherings, school holidays, baking, and seasonal changes remind us of the past while we look to our futures.

The name December comes from the Latin word '*decem*' meaning ten. On the Roman Calendar, December was the 10th month. However, Numa Pompilius adjusted the calendar when January and February were added. December became the twelfth month, and the calendar more accurately reflected the length of a year on Earth.

In December, the winter solstice tips the Northern hemisphere its furthest distance from the sun. Through most of the month, we lose about 2 minutes of sunlight per day until the winter solstice on December 21st. The winter solstice marks the start of winter and the day with the shortest amount of daylight. However, from that day forward, the amount of daylight will slowly increase. The days may not be warmer, but the Earth is tilting on its axis back toward the sun.

Let's look at the Cash Flow Statement for November. Our income took a dramatic rise due to 2024 Dues payments and the collection of payments for the December Christmas party. The \$390.00 collected for the Christmas party this month with the previous amount collected totals \$495.00 and the club will add in \$569.25 to pay for the Holiday Inn gathering on December 16th. We have one check outstanding to the American Cancer Society (Cecil Pines) for \$200.00. As of the December 1st we have \$4,724.30 available funds in our bank account.

A review of our Budget versus Actuals report shows a positive variance for income, and this is due to the collection of Tallahassee Museum fees and the Christmas party payments. Excluding these we have a positive variance of about \$150.00 in income at the end of November. Although the report indicates a positive variance of \$600 for Income-Expense this month, next month we will have a payment of \$110.00 to AACA for Liability Insurance and \$1,064.25 for the Christmas party we will wind up with a negative variance of approximately \$500.00 as we close out the year. Our bank balance will be approximately \$3,600.00. There may be some minor variation depending on any donations and 2024 dues collected before the end of the year. Which brings me to the comment that if you haven't paid your 2024 dues take a minute to write a check for \$20.00 made out to NE FL Region AACA and send it to me at 230 Range Crescent Ct., Fleming Island, FL, 32003.

I have attached a copy of the club roster for your information and review. It includes Wayne Hodges who joined us at the November meeting. Please take a few minutes to review your own information and let me know if it is correct. I must publish a 2024 roster to send to AACA in January, so I'd like to have the roster information updated and corrected.

I want to wish you all the best during this holiday season and may you enjoy the blessings of good health and family thorough out the New Year.
